COVID case in our Nursery/Reception Bubble

2nd July 2021

Dear Parents and Carers

Unfortunately, we have a confirmed COVID case in our Nursery/Reception bubble. This means that the whole bubble (every child in Nursery and Reception) needs to stay at home and self-isolate for 10 days. Day 1 of the self-isolation is today and Day 10 will be Sunday 11th July.

Children in Nursery and Reception will be able to attend school again from Monday 12th July.

At the moment, we only have one confirmed case in the Nursery/Reception bubble and no suspected cases amongst other staff or children. If your child develops symptoms within the 10 day period, they must take a PCR test. If this test is positive, their 10 day self-isolation will start again from the date of their positive test. Please inform school of any suspected/confirmed cases.

Other family members do not need to self-isolate unless your child starts displaying symptoms - in this case, the whole household would then need to self-isolate.
